Indigo Terminal Emulator is a powerful terminal based communication software for telnet and serial terminal communications. Indigo offers many tools and features that are unmatched in other terminal software solutions. These features include the ability to display received data in multiple byte representation formats such as ASCII, DECIMAL, HEXADECIMAL, OCTAL, BINARY, or a user defined custom format. Indigo supports VT100 and Linux terminal emulation protocols as well as a raw data view for non-terminal emulation connections. Indigo supports scripting and simultaneous connected terminal sessions.
